

Alaska Car Transport • Shipping Requirements

1. Valid Picture ID

All registered owners and/or their agents must present a valid picture ID.

2. Current Registration

A copy of the current registration is required. If you are unable to provide a copy of the current registration, please contact your shipping coordinator for additional instructions.

3. Keys

The customer must provide copies of the keys to the ignition, trunk, gas cap and any locked compartment.

****Please Note: Anchorage & Fairbanks will require an appointment for drop-off (MON – FRI) at least 24 hours in advance (all documents must be submitted and confirmed prior to being able to schedule).****

Vehicle Condition Requirements

1. Vehicles must be in safe operating condition

- a. Fully operational brakes, transmission and steering
- b. No leaking fluids
- c. Inflated tires
- d. All windows must be intact and unbroken
- e. The vehicle cabin must be enclosed. For convertibles, the top must be properly installed & attached.

2. One-fourth Tank of gasoline or less

It is required that the tank be no more than $\frac{1}{4}$ full.

3. Clean exterior

The vehicle exterior must be clean and washed so that a thorough inspection can be completed.

4. Vehicle Size

Vehicle must not exceed 260" L, 83" W, or 78" H. If you feel that your vehicle exceeds the dimensions above, please contact (907) 331-3100 and inform your shipping coordinator.

5. Personal items inside vehicle

If you would like to ship personal belongings inside your vehicle, it must be discussed prior to your vehicle being shipped. Your shipping coordinator will notate the weight of the personal items inside the vehicle and your rate will be updated to include personal belongings.

6. No firearms, ammunition or fire extinguishers are allowed in the vehicle

The vehicle exterior must be clean and washed so that a thorough inspection can be completed.

7. If there is an alarm system

The alarm remote must be provided – otherwise the alarm must be disconnected.
